A brief update from Ramat HaNegev:

Over the past two days, we've begun hosting families from central Israel who are seeking safety.

While our region has remained relatively calm, we are still occasionally under threat, including a rocket barrage toward our area just last night.

Our shelters are already in active use, and we're working to better equip them: adding mattresses, fans, and games for the children. Many people are now sleeping in shelters.

There's a constant sense of tension, but also a deep sense of solidarity and a quiet determination to hold on.

We are living through a long and painful chapter in our people's history. But even amid fear and uncertainty, we keep our eyes on a broader horizon

and hold on to hope for a safer future for our children, here in the Middle East.

We are proud to be part of the Jewish people, a nation of extraordinary resilience and brilliance.

For decades, our finest minds have crafted visionary strategies to protect the one and only Jewish state.
